

Grandma Marge's Ham Balls



Ham Balls: 2½ lb. ham loaf 1 cup graham cracker crumbs 1 and a half eggs, beaten 1 cup of milk

Mix thoroughly with hands. Form into small balls. *You may freeze uncooked loaves on a cookie sheet and transfer to storage container or freezer bag. You may also freeze sauce.

Sauce:

1 can tomato soup 1/3 cup vinegar 1 ¹/₄ c. brown sugar 1 t. dry mustard

Combine and pour over pan of loaves.

Bake at 350 to 375 for 1 hour

IRS Increases Contribution Limits for 2019

The Internal Revenue Service just increased the annual contribution limits on IRAs, 401(k)s, and other widely used retirement plan accounts for 2019. Here is a quick look at the changes.

*This year, you can put up to \$6,000 in any type of IRA. The limit is \$7,000 if you will be 50 or older at any time in 2019. (This marks the first increase in yearly IRA contribution limits in six years.)

*Annual contribution limits for 401(k)s, 403(b)s, the federal Thrift Savings Plan, and most 457 plans also get a \$500 boost for 2019. The new annual limit on contributions is \$19,000. If you are 50 or older at any time in 2019, your yearly contribution limit for one of these accounts is \$25,000.

*Are you self-employed, or do you own a small business? You may have a solo 401(k) or a SEP IRA, which allows you to make both an employer and employee contribution. The ceiling on total solo 401(k) and SEP IRA contributions rises \$1,000 in 2019 to \$56,000.

*If you have a SIMPLE retirement account, this year's contribution limit is \$13,000, up \$500 from the 2018 level. If you are 50 or older in 2019, your annual SIMPLE plan contribution cap is \$16,000.

*Yearly contribution limits have also been set a bit higher for Health Savings Accounts (which may be used to save for retirement medical expenses). The 2019 limits: \$3,500 for individuals with single medical coverage, \$7,000 for those covered under qualifying family plans. If you are 55 or older next year, those respective limits are \$1,000 higher.
